

Dr. Takashi Kurumiya President, MSF Japan

Dr. Takashi Kurumiya is a gastrointestinal surgeon. After graduating from Mie University School of Medicine in April 1984, he joined the First Department of Surgery of Mie University, and worked in the surgical department at regional core hospitals in Mie Prefecture, serving as the chief of the operating room at Saiseikai Matsusaka General Hospital. Following that, he worked as Director of the Aichi Hepatobiliary and Pancreatic Hospital, Director of the Operating Room at Kuwana East Medical Center, and Director of the Emergency Department at Mie-Kita Medical Center Inabe General Hospital. He is currently in charge of the emergency department at Nagai Hospital in Tsu, Mie Prefecture. Dr. Kurumiya's career in MSF began in 2004. He has since served 15 surgical field assignments. He was elected to the MSF Japan board in 2006 through 2012 and in 2017. He co-served as vice president from 2018 to 2020 before being elected president of MSF Japan in March 2020.
