After completing his PhD in Economics, Colin Bruce joined the World Bank in 1988 as a Young Professional and spent 30 years working on issues related to economic growth, poverty reduction, fragility, conflict, and violence (FCV), and global crisis risk mitigation and management. Since his recruitment by the ICRC in 2019, he has been supporting efforts to achieve more sustainable humanitarian impact in conflict affected communities, whether they are under the control of the state or not. This role also involves ad hoc collaborations on FCV related issues with academic institutions in Switzerland like EPFL, ETH and IMD.

Bruce is a (pro-bono) Independent member and Co-chair of the Board of the Centre for Disaster Protection in London which specializes in disaster risk finance.
